

**LOWELL CHARTER TOWNSHIP
SPECIAL MEETING
MONDAY, OCTOBER 3, 2005**

The meeting was called to order in the Township Hall by the Supervisor, John Timpson, at 6:58 p.m.

PARK – Proposals from Rieth Riley and Great Lakes Paving were received for paving the gravel parking lot and walkway at the park. Timpson brought in a third bid from Advantage Asphalt. The bids were for 2 inches of asphalt, and additional 1½ inches (second layer), and 2 inches for a 150' x 10' walkway. There was discussion about needing the second layer of asphalt. The Board determined that this was not necessary. The budget will be amended to show that there is an additional \$14,157 in revenue for the park. There was also \$16,000 left from last year's budget for the park that could be used. The total for Rieth Riley is \$22,580 and Great Lakes Paving is \$23,215. The bid from Advantage Asphalt was not considered because it came in too late. Blough moved, Regan seconded, the bid from Rieth Riley for \$17,475 for the parking lot and nos. 4 and 6 totaling \$5,105 for the walkway be accepted for a total bid of \$22,580. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT – Timpson moved, Huver seconded, the meeting adjourn at 7:44 p.m. Motion carried.
