

**LOWELL CHARTER TOWNSHIP  
SPECIAL MEETING  
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2007**

The meeting was called to order in the Township Hall by the Supervisor, Paula Blumm, at 7:02 p.m.

**AGENDA APPROVAL** – Blough moved, Stougaard seconded, the agenda be approved as presented. Motion carried.

**TRUSTEE APPOINTMENT** – Three applications were received for the open Trustee position – Gerald Persha, Michael Seiloff, and William Thompson. Gerald Persha withdrew his application earlier today. Blumm recommended Thompson, stating that while both candidates had good qualifications, Mr. Thompson lives north of the river and there is currently no one on the Board from this area. He also has served for many years on the Zoning Board of Appeals. Both candidates spoke briefly to the Board about their qualifications. Bonn moved, Blough seconded, William Thompson be nominated to fill the trustee position for the remainder of the term. Motion carried. The term expires in November 2008.

The remaining appointments will be filled at the regular meeting on February 20, 2007. There are positions open on the Planning Commission (Board Rep), Zoning Board of Appeals (Board Rep and citizen), LARA, and the Park Committee.

**LOWELL EXPO** – Blumm asked the Board if the Township should participate in the Lowell Expo in March. After discussion, it was decided that the Township would participate and will have a survey about the master plan and the parks ready to pass out.

There will be a joint meeting of the Board, Planning Commission and the Zoning Board of Appeals on March 5, 2007.

Blumm also announced that there will be an open house on Thursday, February 8 for John Timpson.

**CITIZENS' COMMENTS** – A Boardmember commented.

**ADJOURNMENT** – Bonn moved, Stougaard seconded, the meeting adjourn at 7:20 p.m. Motion carried.
